PALM BEACH COUNTY

Fish attractors make 356-acre Lake Osborne an attractive destination for fishing enthusiasts. Largemouth bass, sunshine bass, black crappie, bluegill, redear sunfish and catfish are found here.

Largemouth bass hide near hydrilla and eelgrass. Plastic worms, crankbaits and live shiners are popular ways to catch these species. Jigs and live minnows will fool black crappie. Lake Osborne also is home to sunshine bass, which can be drawn out of deep holes with live shiners. These fish bite well at night. Chicken liver and live worms fished on the bottom will attract channel catfish.

Local anglers also frequent Lake Ida in Delray Beach and Lake Catherine in Palm Beach Gardens. Lake Ida has strong populations of largemouth bass, catfish, sunshine bass and bream.

PALM BEACH, BROWARD & **MIAMI-DADE COUNTIES**

Two Everglades Conservation Areas are highly regarded by fishing enthusiasts. Conservation Area Two features 210 square miles of Everglades marsh surrounded by a perimeter canal. Conservation Area Three consists of 915 square miles of Everglades, wetlands and a canal system. Anglers can catch bluegill, redear sunfish, largemouth bass, catfish and warmouth in these conservation areas.

Largemouth bass anglers like these conservation areas for the catch rates, which are among the highest in the

state. Bream also are caught in these areas using crickets, wigglers and beetle spins.

The Miami-Dade, Broward and West Palm Beach canals provide fishing enthusiasts with opportunity to catch various species. Largemouth bass are commonly found in these canals. Snook and tarpon may be caught in these canals. The exotic butterfly peacock bass, which looks similar to a brightly colored largemouth bass, is found in these waters.

The Miami and Alligator Alley canals offer largemouth bass as well as sunfish, which can be caught with worms and crickets. Mayan cichlid are plentiful and easy to catch with crickets or jigs near the shore.

In Palm Beach County canals, anglers find largemouth bass with live shiners or plastic crawdads. Crickets are a popular bait for bluegill and redear sunfish. Freshwater anglers also have an opportunity to hook snook and tarpon in these canals.

Broward County's canal systems offer largemouth bass. Live shiners also attract the exciting and brilliant butterfly peacock bass, while crickets, red worms and beetle spins are rewarding baits for redear sunfish, bluegill and oscar. Snook and tarpon also travel through these canals, and both can be caught using live shiners and lures resembling baitfish.

PALM BEACH, MARTIN & **GLADES COUNTIES**

Lake Okeechobee measures a total of 730 square miles and is considered one of Florida's best fishing lakes.

However, the negative impact on aquatic habitat and water quality from the 2004 hurricanes still lingers, so up-to-date information on the lake's conditions should be sought before planning a trip there. Under normal conditions, fishing in Lake Okeechobee is excellent for bluegill, redear sunfish, crappie, catfish and largemouth bass.

Lake Okeechobee has a reputation as the "Crappie Capital of the World." The winter months present the best time for catching these fish. Fishing minnows and jigs in open water areas will work well.

Largemouth bass fishing is most active on Lake Okeechobee during the late winter months and into spring. Golden shiners, spinnerbaits and crankbaits are just a few of the baits that are productive for largemouth bass in these areas. Catfish are abundant year-round and are easiest to catch when fished on the lake bottom.

MARTIN COUNTY

Boating and fishing excursions are popular pastimes in Martin County-home to more than 20 marinas, a dozen fishing charter and boat tour companies, plus a variety of bait and tackle shops,. Martin County reigns supreme for sport fishing, and holds the distinctive title of "Sailfish Capital of the World."

kayaking, river cruises and fishing tournaments. Martin County accommodates all those beckoned by the water including such waterways as Ocean, Atlantic the Lake Okeechobee, and the Indian, St. Lucie and Loxahatchee rivers. Martin County also accesses Florida's only cross-state canal via the St.Lucie Locks and Okeechobee Waterway system to the west coast.

MONROE COUNTY

Flamingo is a popular destination for boating, fishing and bird watching, possibly due to its exotic location at the southern tip of the Everglades National Park in Florida Bay. One hundred years ago, Flamingo was virtually inaccessible. It has since become an angler's haven for adventurous and scenic fishing. This beautiful location is where the freshwater of the Everglades meets the saltwater of the Keys. This region is the only spot in the world where saltwater crocodiles and alligators coexist. In this region, which is less than an hour away from metropolitan Miami, a fisherman can target tarpon, snook, redfish, seatrout, jack crevalle, shark, snapper, Goliath



grouper, cobia and tripletail.

The Florida Keys offers more than 225 species of gamefish, including bonefish, tarpon and marlin, making the Keys a premier fishing destination for sport fishermen. Ten percent of the world's fishing records have been set here.

With a range of waters as deep as 2,000 feet, Key Largo provides an enormous amount of sea life. This system creates an opportunity for the best backcountry and deep-sea fishing adventures. Backcountry fishermen can catch redfish, snook and trout. Sailfish, wahoo, king mackerel, dolphin and tuna can be caught when trolling. November to January is the best time to catch sailfish in Key Largo. Bottom fishing provides an opportunity to catch grouper, yellowtail, king mackerel, cobia and snapper.

The best fishing venues in *Key West* are around natural reefs, shipwrecks and flats. However, Hemingway preferred to fish the Florida Straights, between Cuba and

Key West, for giant blue marlin. During the winter months, cobia, barracuda, shark, king mackerel, sailfish, permit and tuna are biting. Spring and fall offer tarpon, permit, bonefish, marlin, wahoo and dolphin. Key West summers are known for their abundance of large tarpon, as well as grouper, snapper, marlin and wahoo.

POMPANO BEACH

Pompano Beach is located in the heart of the "Gold Coast" and has some of the best fishing in the area. Taking the Hillsboro Inlet out to sea will provide anglers with an extensive variety of fish, from dolphin and sailfish to snapper, grouper and amberjack. Within the last decade, the Pompano Beach Fishing Rodeo organization has created a massive offshore reef system in the waters off of Pompano Beach. The group sunk more than 20 freighters at depths exceeding 100 feet, improving an already excellent fishing locale.
